Notification of the Ministry of Public Health
No. 44 B.E. 2523 (1978)
Re: Husked Rice Flour

It deems appropriate to amend notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Husked Rice Flour.

By the virtue of provisions of Section 5 and 6 (10) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979); the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. Husked Rice Flour are prescribed food to have label

Clause 2. Label of Husked Rice Flour shall follow to the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Label and shall declare “Do not feed infants” in red bold alphabets height of not be less than 5 mm at the lower of the declaration “Husked Rice Flour”

Clause 3. Label in any picture, pictorial, invented designs shall be not false or deceptive to create gullibility or misleading its important characteristics for feed infants.

This notification shall come into force as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
