Notification of the Ministry of Public Health

Re: Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein (No.2)

It deems appropriate to amend the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health; Re: Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein.

By the virtue of provisions of Section 5 and 6 (3) (4) (6) (7) and (10) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), in which contain provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the Persons, in respect of which Section 29 and in conjunction with Section 33, Section 41, Section 43 and Section 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. The following texts shall be added as (9) of Clause 4 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health Re: Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein dated 6th May B.E. 2553 (2010)

“(9) Iodine content is as follows;

(9.1) Not less than 2 mg and not more than 3 mg in 1 liter of food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein that added iodine in production process or;

(9.2) Subject to an approval by the Food and Drug Administration for food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein that used of edible iodized salt as an ingredient, such salt shall have standards complied with the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Edible salt”

Clause 2. Text in Clause 5 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health Re: Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein dated 6th May B.E. 2553 (2010) shall be repealed and replaced with the following texts;

“Clause 5. Food seasonings derived from the hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein and water evaporated shall have qualities or standards complied with (1) (3.4) of (3) (4) (8) and (9) of Clause 4 and other stipulations made by the Food and Drug Administration”.

Clause 3. The following texts shall be added as Clause 9/1 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein dated 6th May B.E. 2553 (2010);

“Clause 9/1 Making an exception to comply with (9) of Clause 4 for food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein which have purpose for person who have to restrict for iodine consumption and make a declaration with clearly legible letter on a label “for restricted iodine consumption person”.

Clause 4. Food seasoning derived from hydrolysis or fermentation of soybean protein manufactured for export shall not be enforced by this Notification.

Clause 5. This Notification shall come into force after 90 days as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
