**Notification of the Ministry of Public Health  
Re: Labeling of food composed in a container**

For benefit and protection of consumer.

By the virtue of provisions of Section 5 and 6 (10) of the Food Act B.E.2522 (1979), in which contain provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the Persons, in respect of which Section 29 and in conjunction with Section 33, Section 41, Section 43 and Section 45 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. Stipulation of food, more than one kinds or many unit of the same kinds packed and wrapped together in one container either basket, box, bag or any kinds of container shall be a food that has labeling.

Clause 2. Labeling of food in Clause 1 shall be in clearly legible Thai language and shall have the following texts:

(1) Name, type or kind of each unit of food packed;

(2) Day/month/year of “expiration date” or “should consume before date” of food in (1)

Clause 3. This notification shall come into force as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
