Notification of Ministry of Public Health

Re: Chocolate (No. 2)

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It deems appropriate to amend the notification of the Ministry of Public Health, Re: Chocolate concerning more appropriate requirements for yeast and mould.

By the virtue of provisions of Section 5 in the first phrase, and 6 (3) and (9) of the Food Act B.E. 2522 (1979), in which contain provisions in relation to the restriction of Rights and Liberties of the Persons, in respect of which Section 29 and in conjunction with Section 33, Section 41, Section 43 and Section 45 of the constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand so permit by virtue of provisions of law; the Minister of Public Health hereby issues the notification as follows:

Clause 1. Text in (4) of Clause 3 of the Notification of the Ministry of Public Health (No. 83) B.E. 2527 (1984), Re: Chocolate, dated 15<sup>th</sup> November B.E. 2527 (1984) shall be repealed and replaced with the following text:

“(4) Detected yeast and mold shall be less than 100 in 1 gram of chocolate

Use updated version of Bacteriological Analytical Manual (BAM) Online U.S. Food and Drug Administration or equivalent method as Method of analysis of such yeast and mold”.

Clause 2. This notification shall come into force as from the day following date of its publication in the Government Gazette.
